Blessed Sacrament Catholic School students, who are from families that are active members at Blessed Sacrament Church, are eligible for the parishioner tuition rate. Blessed Sacrament Parish verifies the active parishioner status of their families according to our specific, parish-established criteria. Periodic reviews verify whether the parishioner status has continued as active and whether the parishioner rate continues to be appropriate.

*Upon re-enrollment, a review of Active Parishioner Status will take place in April 2020.*

*Verification is needed before the "Parishioner" tuition rate for 2020-2021 can be assigned.*

An active parishioner family is one who has been duly registered in the parish for at least 3 months, participates in worship through attendance at weekend Masses, evidenced by weekly envelopes in the offertory, and actively involved in a parish or school ministry, and participates in Grateful Sacrificial Giving.

*If you give online, please turn in your empty envelopes weekly at Mass and check "I give online."  
If you contribute periodically through the collection, please remember to put in empty envelopes weekly and mark "I attended Mass."*

*Contributions in cash can only be considered when presented in the parish envelope.*

Although the criteria constitute a minimum description of one who is actively involved in the parish, an active parishioner can do much more than this, depending on time, ability, and circumstances.
