The teachers at Blessed Sacrament Catholic School have been diligently working to analyze the data from the students MAP scores to create Personalized Study Plans for each student.

In working with the data from the most recent Spring MAP test, each teacher has worked within the MAP and IXL programs to create a personalized study plan through IXL for your child. Your child has a specific list of IXL skills to work on to help him/her grow academically from the current level they are at. Students in grades 2-8 have been instructed how to access their personalized study plans through IXL. We encourage your child to pick from a variety of lessons from different standards.

- Login to IXL with student username and password, click on My IXL tab
- Click STUDY PLANS - NWEA MAP Growth Study Plan
- Complete each lesson to at least 80%

Please take the time to look over the skill areas assigned to your child. You may notice skills that are on grade level, above grade level or below grade level. This is the beauty of the program - It allows your child to work at his/her academic level and possibly beyond grade level. Since the skill plans are created based on MAP scores, there may be assignments beyond your child's current academic ability. You can "find examples or videos" of the skill on the assignment page at the top. If your child is working on a skill that is too difficult or is taking a long period of time, this is an indicator that you should adjust the skill or level. Please allow them to adjust the grade level or pick a different skill. You can adjust the level at the bottom of the skill page labeled "not quite ready yet."

Our hope is connecting MAP and IXL as summer work will help each child grow academically. It is also our hope that our students will enjoy taking charge of their own learning.
